- Letter of Recommendation One letter only from candidate's Faculty or Professional Adviser.

Forms must arrive by mail at PRSSA Headquarters by 5 p.m. ET on February 1. Please mail your complete application with adequate time for delivery. Faxed or emailed forms will not be accepted.
